Pope Francis to the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart: "Your is a Journey of Faith"

On October 2, 2023, Pope Francis addressed the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart during their 26th General Chapter. The Holy Father began his address by acknowledging the MSCs history. Founded by Father Chevalier in 1854, he envisioned them as Missionaries of God's love; the Holy Father stated "He thought of you from the very beginning as Missionaries, committed to making God's love known in the world in order to obtain from men a response of love." The Holy Father emphasized the importance of knowing the Heart of Jesus through the Gospel, referring to it as "the book 'of the Sacred Heart.'" He urged the Missionaries to meditate on Jesus's life, where they would discover His immense mercy, love, and compassion, "For this powerful experience to become light for the journey, it must also pass through the enrichment of sharing. Here is the second element: deepening and understanding the Word in fraternal sharing." Pope Francis then shifted his focus to the importance of deepening understanding through fraternal sharing. He drew parallels with the disciples on the road to Emmaus who, after recognizing Jesus, shared their amazement and experiences with one another. This act of sharing joy and wonder when encountering the Lord is a practice that Pope Francis encouraged the Missionaries to adopt. He also highlighted the role of sharing in Father Chevalier's life, mentioning how he shared his fervor and dreams with fellow companions, whom he referred to as "knights of the Sacred Heart." He commended the Missionaries for adopting the motto "'from ego to echo,' that is, from self to common home, to family, to community, to creation." This shift, he explained, encompasses a commitment to serve as a common home for family, community, and creation. "Faced with them, do not be afraid to allow yourselves to be caught up in the compassion of the Heart of Christ; as your Founder said,

Planned Giving

Are you turning 73 this year? Has your financial institution told you that you have to take a required minimum distribution from your IRA? Are you thinking to yourself, "I don't really need that money"? If so, it may make sense to call your financial advisor and ask her to set up a charitable distribution directly from your IRA.

Individuals over age 70 1/2 can donate up to \$100,000 from an IRA directly to a qualified charity without triggering any federal income taxes. Under the qualified charitable distributions provision, you request a distribution from your IRA and provide your financial advisor with the name and address of the qualifying charity. The distribution can be sent directly to the charity of your choice...like the Sacred Heart Foundation!

There are a number of potential tax benefits to you for making a charitable contribution directly from your IRA.

(1) Income tax on the distribution is avoided, even if you do not itemize deductions and even if your gifts exceed the percentage of income limits for charitable deductions.

(2) The distribution does not increase your adjusted gross income for purposes of reducing

adjusted gross income for purposes of reducing itemized deductions, nor does it limit the amount of deductible medical expenses or miscellaneous itemized deductions or increase the taxation of your Social Security benefits.

(3) If the state you live in determines taxable income based on federal adjusted gross. income based on federal adjusted gross income, there is no state income tax on the distribution, even if the state does not allow the charitable deduction.

Maybe now is the time to speak to your financial advisor or tax professional to see if a donation directly from your IRA to the Sacred Heart Foundation, makes sense for you.

allow him to love through you and to manifest his mercy through your goodness." The Holy Father acknowledged the numerous challenges faced by the Missionaries, such as serving the poor and migrants, and addressing injustices worldwide. He encouraged them to embrace the compassion of the Heart of Christ and allow His tenderness to shape their plans and projects. "Please do not be afraid of tenderness! God's style can be said in three words: closeness, compassion, and tenderness. God is like that: close, compassionate, tender. Be like this with others." In closing, Pope Francis highlighted the indispensable role of prayer in cultivating the qualities of closeness, compassion, and tenderness. "Thank you, dear brothers, for what you are and what you do! Continue your work with enthusiasm. Flee from sadness, which is the cankerworm that ruins personal and consecrated life! That sadness that brings you down, not the good sadness of repentance, that is another thing, but that daily sadness is a woodworm that ruins. I bless you from my heart. And I recommend that you pray for me, because I need it, this work is not so easy! Thank you."
