The Scholarship Committee reviewed applications from eight different provinces. Eighty MSC seminary students will receive financial assistance. This is possible only through the generosity of our supporters. This is the highest annual award that the Sacred Heart Foundation has dispensed in scholarships. Since inception, the Sacred Heart Foundation has awarded over \$2.05 million in scholarships to seminarians around the world.

If you are considering a charitable contribution this year, it is in your best interest to seek out the most effective manner in which your money can work for you. Gifting appreciated stock is one of the most effective means of tax savings available. There are three benefits for you to consider: 1) The satisfaction of knowing your money is invested in a cause important to you. 2) Capital gains taxes on the stock are avoided. 3) You will be eligible to receive an income tax charitable deduction for the full fair market value of the stock at the time of the gift.

To qualify for these special tax advantages, the security must have been held for at least one year. Your gift of appreciated stock is fully deductible up to 30% of your adjusted gross income. For example, if your adjusted gross income is \$100,000, up to \$30,000 of long term appreciated stock and other capital gain property may generally be deducted, although high income donors may be subject to a partial phase out of itemized deductions.

Getting to know our MSC - Fr. Joseph Christy, MSC



Fr. Joseph Christy was born in Bangalore, India in a family with five brothers and one sister. "I grew up in Bangalore. My family is a traditional Catholic family who attended Mass regularly and prayed every day. They used to pray for vocations in family prayers." [From an interview with The Mexican American Catholic College] He was ordained on June 20, 2001 in Bangalore. He served as Asst. Pastor and Pastor in various churches around Bangalore. From 2005-2009 he served as Superior of the Formation House for Pre-Novitiate before being appointed Union Superior for three years. At the end of April 2014, he arrived in the United States and began parish ministry as Parochial Vicar at St. Patrick/St. Anthony Parishes in Watertown, NY. He loved this first experience in our country, especially the Watertown parishioners and the beautiful places to visit.

He held that position for 2¹/₂ years, before moving back to India to defend his thesis for his Master's Degree in Canon Law. On July 1, 2019 he was assigned to work in the United States again as Parochial Vicar at St. Catherine of Alexandria, Riverside, CA, a multicultural, multilingual community. Because the Spanish language is a pastoral need there, he participated in an Intensive Pastoral Spanish Program in Texas. Fr. Christy loves being a priest. Despite the many cultural challenges he faces, he states "it is the grace of God that inspires and energizes me to do His work among the people of God." What Fr. Christy says he likes best about California is "the climate is very similar to [my] hometown and no need to get up early to check how much snow is present to clean my way to the church." This is a sentiment with which everyone in Northern New York can empathize. There are several other MSC priests working in this community from many areas of the world including Philippines, Indonesia, Korea, and 2 more from India as well as 2 who serve the Native American Reservation in Soboba and 3 who belong to the USA province in Palm Springs. How very fortunate we are to have so many MSC priests to help in our country. Fr. Christy has had some very sad days since he has been in the US; his mother passed away this past August and his oldest brother just this March. Fr. Christy returned to India briefly for each funeral and is now back in California. Thank you, Fr. Christy, and all your fellow MSC priests as well. God Bless you all.
