The Vocation of Priesthood

According to a census taken in 2012, it was reported that, worldwide, there were a total of 414, 313 priests. The total number of priests has remained the same since the 1970s. Meanwhile the Catholic population has doubled from 653.6 million to 1.229 billion in 2012. With numbers like these, the Catholic Church has been experiencing a priest shortage for years. The same census reported that the number of parishes without priests grew to 49,153, and that number continues to increase as the years have gone by. As the population increases, the Catholic population increases as well as its demand for priests. According to the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart 2018 March newsletter, there are currently 1,700 MSC priests and brothers serving around the globe.

The Sacred Heart Foundation's mission is to provide financial assistance to those studying to be MSC priests and brothers anywhere in the world. The scholarships that are awarded annually aid those in the vocation of priesthood and brotherhood who cannot afford seminary school without financial assistance. A majority of the scholarships that are awarded are to seminary students overseas. The Missionaries of the Sacred Heart 2018 March Newsletter states that "Bridging cultural diversity is one of the greatest challenges facing the world and the Church." The Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate (CARA) findings on "Cultural Diversity in the Catholic Church in the United States" estimates that 58% of the Catholic population is white, 34% is Hispanic/Latino, 3% is Black/African American, 3% is Asian, 1% is American Indian/Alaskan Native and 1% is Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander. With this amount of diversity, the Catholic Church is in diverse priests who can relate to its parishioners.

With the vocation of priesthood growing in third world and developing countries, this provides a hope for an influx of priests and brothers to areas that are in need of them, such as the United States According to our sources, the United States currently has 62 MSC Priests; of those 62, 33 have received scholarships from the Sacred Heart Foundation; they have been assigned to parishes in New York, Illinois, Pennsylvania and California. This year, the Sacred Heart Foundation was able to award 62 scholarships totaling \$82,500.00. With your support, we hope to steadily decrease the shortage of priests by providing financial assistance to those called to vocation of priesthood and brotherhood.

Should You Start Bunching?

So what exactly do we mean by bunching? Let's start with everyone's favorite topic.... taxes. You may not fully appreciate the changes coming your way when you file your 2018 tax return. According to a recent survey conducted by Fidelity Investments, eighty-two percent of Americans who itemized charitable deductions on their 2017 tax returns plan to maintain or increase their giving this year. The same poll also found that fifty-eight percent of donors still planned to itemize their return in 2018, even though doing so may not be appropriate to their situation. This suggests many donors may not have fully worked out how the increase standard deduction in the revised tax code affects them.

Half of households with incomes less than \$100,000 currently plan to itemize their 2018 taxes. Most of these donors will likely discover that their itemizations, including charitable donations, will not push their total deduction amount past the new standard deduction thresholds of \$12,000 for individuals and \$24,000 for couples. In short, what may have been a charitable deduction for you in the past may no longer make any difference when you file your tax return with a standard deduction.

Charitably inclined tax filers should consider bunching their contributions. This simply means grouping multiple years of deductions (such as charitable contributions) into a single year in order to surpass the standard deduction.

Remember, you qualify for a named scholarship once your lifetime contributions to the Sacred Heart Foundation exceed \$15,000. Perhaps now is the right time to achieve this milestone? It will help the Foundation's mission around the globe and may help you when you file your income tax for 2018.
