Timothy Cannan** as our Guest Speaker for this year's **Annual Benefit Dinner** on **Tuesday**, **September 18**, **2018**, at the **Hilton Garden Inn**, Watertown NY. Father Timothy Canaan has his roots at Our Lady of the Sacred Heart parish, having been born and raised here, and is also a graduate of Immaculate Heart Central School.



Following his graduation, Father Canaan attended Wadhams Hall Seminary-College and completed his education and formation at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, Maryland.

Father Canaan celebrated his first Mass at Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Church with many of his family and friends present to share in the liturgy. He then served as parochial vicar at St. Mary's in Ticonderoga and Church of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in Crown Point. In 1995, he became parochial vicar at St. John's in Plattsburgh. In 1998, he was named administrator in Willsboro and Essex as well as Director of Vocations for the diocese of Ogdensburg.

In 2002, Father Canaan was named pastor of St. Mary's Parish in Canton as well as the St. Thomas More Campus. He has been pastor at St. John the Baptist, Plattsburgh which includes worship sites at St. John's and the John XXIII Newman Center Campus parish since 2008.

Father Canaan has served as the director of campus ministry for the diocese since 2007. He is a popular retreat leader for parishes across the diocese. He is a very passionate and powerful speaker, enjoyed by both young and old.

We are very proud to have Father Timothy Canaan with us. The Sacred Heart Foundation in Watertown is pleased to announce that Randy Fipps joined the Board of Directors in May of 2018.



Planned Giving

If you are considering a charitable contribution this year, it is in your best interest to seek out the most effective manner in which your money can work for you. Gifting appreciated stock is one of the most effective means of tax savings available. There are three benefits for you to consider: 1) The satisfaction of knowing your money is invested in a cause important to you. 2) Capital gains taxes on the stock are avoided. 3) You will be eligible to receive an income tax charitable deduction for the full fair market value of the stock at the time of the gift.

To qualify for those special tax advantages, the security must have been held for at least one year. Your gift of appreciated stock is fully deductible up to 30% of your adjusted gross income. For example, if your adjusted gross income is \$100,000, up to \$30,000 of long term appreciated stock and other capital gain property may generally be deducted, although high income donors may be subject to a partial phase out of itemized deductions.




In Memory of Fr. Mark McDonald, MSC July 22, 1942-April 2, 2018
